- Materials donated to Aultmore Park Primary
- Storage container to Aultmore Park Primary
- Industry Challenge event with Glasgow Kelvin College
- New central heating boiler and pipework in The Connie.

## **Technical Services News**

## **Planned Maintenance**

It is going to be an extremely busy 12 months for the technical services team with an investment programme worth over £400,000 of replacement and improvement works planned throughout the area.

This year will be more challenging than most as a lot of this investment work will be delayed due to the current medical emergency. However, be assured that staff are working hard in the background to ensure we can get our contractors back working on projects again as soon as is safe to do so.

#### The work will include:

#### Bathroom Replacements

6 closes in Conisborough Road 2 closes in Balfluig Street

#### Controlled Entry Systems

6 closes in Conisborough Road2 closes in Balfluig Street

8 closes in Whitslade Street

#### Close Painting

4 internal closes getting re-painted in Conisborough Road 15 internal closes getting re-painted in Auchinlea Road 2 internal closes getting re-painted in Conisborough Road

#### External Painting

Homes in 31 closes in Auchinlea Road, Balcurvie Road, Conisborough Road, Whitslade Street, Balfluig Street are getting external windows frames, doors, roof timbers, fences and clothes poles re-painted.

All this work will be done in stages throughout the coming 12 months and affected tenants will be notified prior to any work starting to arrange access.

## Phase 13 New Build

The first new homes are now completed and the first of many new tenants have moved in. They look great and so far the feedback from the new tenants has been really good.

After a number of delays during the winter, due to services connections out with the contractors control, the contractor ENGIE had programmed to hand over the remaining homes by the end of May. However, this will not be possible now as all handover progress has been postponed because of the Coronavirus emergency. This means that the completion of the site will now be delayed until the end of the summer, at the earliest.
